ORDER GIVING APPROVAL TO GRANT OF LICENCES UNDER SECTIONS 17B AND 17DA

Under sections 17B and 17DA of the Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978 I, Lily D'Ambrosio MP, Minister for Energy, Environment and Climate Change, being satisfied that there are special reasons which make the granting of licences reasonable and appropriate in the particular circumstances and to do this will not be substantially detrimental to the use and enjoyment of any adjacent land reserved under the Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978, approve the granting of licences by the delegated land managers to the Warrnambool Racing Club and or to individual horse trainers, for a term not exceeding two (2) years for the purpose of 'horse training on beaches' over the area of Crown land being portion of beaches between Warrnambool and Port Fairy described in the Schedule below and, in accordance with section 17B(3)(a) of the Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978, state that -

- there are special reasons which make granting the licences reasonable and appropriate (a) in the particular circumstances; and
- to do this will not be substantially detrimental to the use and enjoyment of any (b) adjacent land reserved under the Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978.
