Would you like a receipt with that? A lack of detail and scrutiny sums up the use of one W'bool City Council credit card.

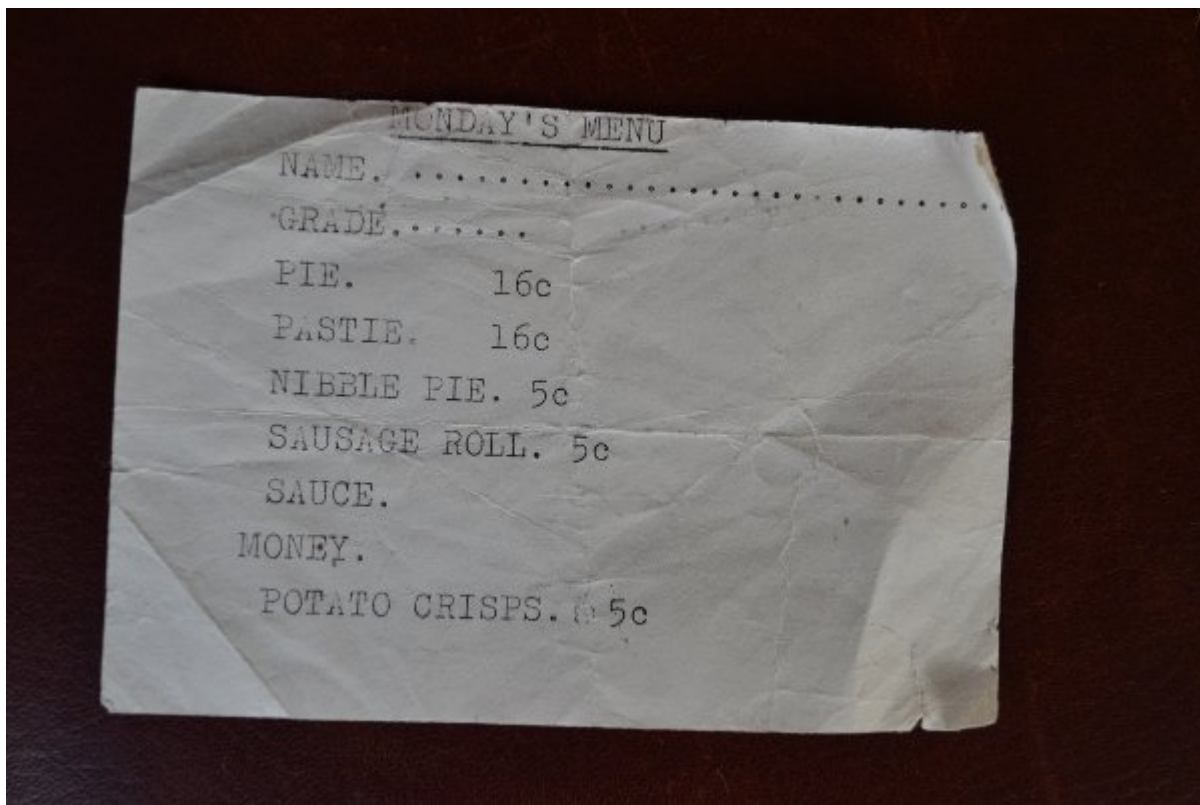
